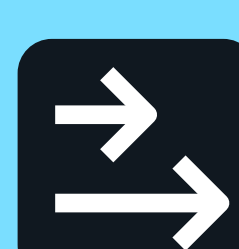

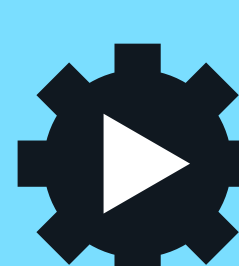
Provides one place for law enforcement agencies to upload digital evidence.

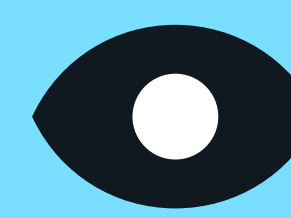
